

MUHC Reproductive Centre Checklist for Directed Sperm Donation (Process 6 to 8 months)

1. **RECIPIENT –** Visit #1 - Initial consultation with physician

After this visit:

- Scan the QR code to read the Instructions for Directed Sperm Donation
- Repeat baseline tests / other tests (if applicable)
- □ Consultation with the Psychologist (\$)
- Sign RAMQ Undertaking forms (if applicable) one for you, one for your partner

2. RECIPIENT – Visit #2 - Follow-up consultation with physician Documents to bring:

- RAMQ Undertaking forms (if applicable)
- Treatment consent
- Covid-19 consent form.

After this visit:

- □ If going with a known donor (directed donation) continue to step 3
- □ If using a sperm bank, scan the QR code to read "Donor Sperm Bank FAQs" Note: the checklist is no longer applicable

3. RECIPIENT

□ Inform your potential sperm donor to open a file at the MUHC Reproductive Centre

4. SPERM DONOR - Visit #1 - Initial consultation with physician

After this visit:

- Scan the QR code to read the Instructions for Directed Sperm Donation
- □ Consultation with the Psychologist* (\$)
- Semen Analysis
- Blood and urine tests
- Complete, sign the Initial Screening Form
- Complete and sign the 202-E Consent to Donate Sperm
- Complete and sign Covid-19 Consent

*Typically, the recipient reimburses the sperm donor for the consultation with the psychologist.

5. SPERM DONOR – Visit #2 - Follow-up consultation with physician

ATTENTION ! All the steps under #4 must be completed before this appointment.

Documents to bring:

- □ Initial Screening Form
- 202-E Consent to Donate sperm
- Covid-19 Consent

After this visit:

After the payment is done by the recipient, complete steps 8 to 10 below.

6. (If applicable) RECIPIENT – Follow-up consultation with the physician

The physician <u>may</u> request this consultation to review the potential risks associated with using sperm from your donor, based on the initial screening, before the donor proceed with the donation.

7. RECIPIENT – Payment (phone or in person)

Payment for direct sperm donation process (\$2500)* *This does not included the price of treatment (if applicable)

8. SPERM DONOR – Visit #3 – Physical Examination

9. SPERM DONOR – Visit #4 – Appointment for Sperm Donation During this visit:

- Repeat blood and urine tests (serology) for infectious diseases
- Pre-Donation Screening form to complete
- Sperm donation

10. SPERM DONOR – Visits # 5 - 7 – Additional Donation appointments

Step 9 can be repeated up to 4 times within 6 months (included in the \$2500 fee). Additional fees apply for extra samples (\$350 each).

11. RECIPIENT – Visit #3 – After sperm banking - Communication of risk

During this visit:

□ Sign the communication of risk with the physician

Documents to bring:

- Treatment consent form
- Covid-19 Consent

12. RECIPIENT – Start of treatment
