CHEAT SHEET FOR **ED PSYCHIATRY**

Triggers for general activation of the Overcapacity Plan (one trigger is needed)

1) During the first six months of go-live:

- Emergency Department (ED) Occupancy Thresholds:
 - 170 % Glen
 - 150 % MGH

Excluding patients with imminent discharges

2) After the first six months of go-live:

- ED Occupancy Thresholds:
 - 150 % Glen
 - 130 % MGH

Excluding patients with imminent discharges


Phases of the Overcapacity Plan

Phase 1: Capacity optimisation

- Identify to NIC tests, procedures, or consults that will result in discharge.
- Fast-track discharges. Patients not requiring inpatient admission must be a priority in order to free up ED beds.
- Identify to UC consults that will lead to patient discharge to be prioritized (target within 1 hr).

Phases 2, 3 and 4: continue efforts underway
