6. Update from the President and Executive Director

Emergency Situation at the Glen Site

- Code silver launched following reports of gunshots heard at the south exterior of the hospital (August 24, 2021)
- Emergency code was lifted at around 4:30 a.m., with the safe resumption of all patient care and regular activities
- Investigation conducted by the SPVM
- Increased support services offered to support staff, residents and physicians
- Debrief (hot/cold) conducted by MUHC Emergency Measures Coordination Centre to improve the handling of these rare events and making any necessary changes to the emergency response plan







Where are we today?


Key Facts:

- Current 7 day case average: 754
- Current hospitalizations: 280
- Current ICU admissions: 92
- Double vaccination rates:
 - 83% of eligible pop
 - 73% of total population
 - 70% of total pop >7 days from 2nd dose















Delta is more transmissible



- UK variant was 2x as contagious as original strain
- Delta is 2x as contagious as the UK variant
- Viral loads are up to 1000-fold higher
- Incubation period is shorter
- Shedding may be longer






Incubation period

Delta: 3-4 d Original strain: 5-6 d

Delta is more virulent



- Scottish study: risk of hospitalization
 2x vs Alpha
- Ontario data: 120% increase in hospitalizations vs original strain
- In Qc: although hospitalization rate is lower than 2nd wave, the fraction in ICU is higher
- CDC studies found no increase in hospitalization or ICU rates in children



Does vaccination protect against Delta?



Severe illness and hospitalization

Pfizer

UK: 96% effective

Israel: 93% effective


Moderna

Canada: 96% effective

AstraZeneca

UK: 92% effective

Canada: 88% effective



Vaccinated individuals in Qc have a 35-fold lower rate of hospitalization!




Does vaccination protect against Delta?



Symptomatic disease

- Studies from around the world show efficacy ~65-85%
- Multiple studies demonstrate
 - Vaccine breakthrough can transmit
 - Viral load in unvaccinated and vaccine breakthrough infections are the same
 - Likely shorter illness if vaccinated

Take home message: breakthrough infections in double vaccinated individuals can transmit!




UK Hospital Admissions

A note of caution: ICU beds



Compared with 2nd wave

- Daily cases are 1/3 of 2nd wave peak
- In infected individuals:
 - Hospitalization rates in infected individuals are 50% lower
 - ICU admission rates in infected individuals are the same



What about declining immunity?



Do we need boosters?

- Israel: 75% vs 16% protection for those vaccinated in April vs January
- US studies protection against all COVID illness
 - Mayo Clinic data: protection against Delta
 76% in January to 42% in July
 - 2nd study: 92% in May to 80% in July
 - Nursing home study: 75% in March to 53% in July

New Israel data, 3rd dose in >60 yrs old

20-fold reduction in severe illness




But – is this relevant in Quebec



Israel (and US) administered 2nd dose at 21d

Delayed 2nd dose = better immunity

- UK study, 172 Pfizer recipients, >80 yrs
- Randomized to 3 week or 12 week delay
- Antibody titers 3.5 times higher in delayed vaccinated group!


- Vaccines in pediatric population
