I am an Orthopaedic Surgeon at the MUHC - Montreal General Hospital site. I did my Orthopaedic Residency at McGill University, followed by an 18-month adult reconstructive fellowship at Harvard University and the Massachusetts General Hospital. Subsequently, I returned to Montreal and have been at the Montreal General Hospital for the last 27 years. Currently, I am a Professor of Surgery and the Vice Chair (Clinical) of Surgery at McGill University. In addition, I am the Associate Surgeon-in-Chief of the McGill University Hospital Centre (MUHC). I have been actively involved in planning and operations with the Surgical Mission, Nursing, the Hospital Administration and members of the Ministry of Health.

Raisons motivant la candidature :

Many of the recent changes at the MUHC have been financially driven, and have been at the expense of patient care and innovation. It is important that going forward, the Board's vision and oversight of the MUHC ensures that physicians can provide the best care to every patient through integrated clinical practice, education and research.
