

WELCOME TO THE CEDARS CANCER CENTRE

The Cedars Cancer Centre of the McGill University Health Centre (MUHC) is a multidisciplinary oncology day centre where adult cancer patients receive world-class treatment, care and support.

YOUR FIRST APPOINTMENT

Your oncology pathway will begin with a consultation with a surgical, medical or radiation oncologist at the MUHC. At your first visit, you will meet your doctor as well as other members of your healthcare team. Your doctor will review your medical history, current health status, and the results of any tests you have had.

You will be contacted by a hospital clerk to book your first appointment. The clerk will explain how the clinics work and tell you which waiting area you should go to once you have arrived at the Cedars Cancer Centre.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

- A list of all medications you are currently taking, including any over-the-counter medications
- Any reports you may have from tests or medical consultations done outside the MUHC
- Your up-to-date RAMQ card







WHAT DO I DO WHEN I ARRIVE AT THE CEDARS CANCER CENTRE?

- Scan your RAMQ card at a check-in kiosk. This
 lets the healthcare team know that you've arrived.
 There are two kiosks on the RC level, and one on
 the S1 level.
- · Take a seat in the appropriate waiting area.
- Watch the TV screens regularly. When your name appears (your first name plus the first three letters of your family name), proceed to the location shown beside it.
- If you need help, see one of the Cedars
 CanSupport volunteers, who wear royal blue vests.

REGISTERING AS A PATIENT AND KEEPING YOUR FILE UP TO DATE

New patients: If you are going to the MUHC for the first time, you must register and create a file at the Admitting Office (CRC.0046), which is located in the atrium near the main entrance of the Royal Victoria Hospital.

Returning patients: If there has been a change in your personal information (address, home or cell phone number, email address, etc.) since your last visit, please go to the Admitting Office to update your file before your next appointment.
