To prepare for your placement, please review the following:

Conditions/Topics:

1. Cardiac surgeries: ACBP, AVR, MVR, Bentall and Maze procedures, LVAD implantation (Ex: heartmate, heartware, c-pulse)

- 2. Heart Transplant
- 3. Heart rhythms (Ex: Atrial fibrillation, Flutter)
- 4. DVT: signs, symptoms, precautions
- 5. INR: what it is, contraindications
- 6. Delirium

Medications: be aware of their indications, as well as side effects and precautions in physiotherapy.

- 1. Anticoagulants (Ex: Heparin, Coumadin)
- 2. Pain meds (Ex: Naproxen, Oxycodone)
- 3. Lasix
- 4. Digoxin
- 5. Cardizem
- 6. Beta blocker (ex: Metoprolol, Sotolol)

Assessment/treatment:

- 1. Cardioresp evaluation: Auscultation, need for chest physio
- 2. Chest Physio [aka CPT] (Ex: percussions, vibes)
- 3. Neuro screening and assessment
