Conditions/Topics:

- 1. Anatomy/Functional anatomy
- 2. Orthopaedic conditions (Ex: fractures, strains, back pain)
- 3. Pathology: soft tissue and fracture healing
- 4. Rheumatological conditions (Ex: RA, OA)
- 5. Central vs peripheral nerve injury
- 6. Orthopedic OR procedures (Ex: spinal fusion, discectomy, ORIF)

Medications: be aware of their indications, as well as side effects and precautions in physiotherapy.

- 1. Anti-inflammatories (NSAIDS, steroids)
- 2. Analgesics
- 3. Metabolic meds (Metformin, synthroid)

Assessment/Treatment:

- 1. Bony landmarks
- 2. Dermatomes/Myotomes/reflex patterns
- 3. Cervical and Lumbar Scan
- 4. Goniometry and MMT
- 5. Exercise therapy
- 6. Modalities (indications/contraindications)
- 7. Manual therapy, McKenzie method
- 8. Red flags/contraindications to therapy
