To prepare for your placement, please review the following:

## **Conditions/Topics:**

- 1. Upper Extremity Anatomy(shoulder, elbow, wrist, hand): bone, muscle, innervation
- 2. Common conditions: IE distal radial treatment, tendon lacerations, CRPS
- 3. Repetitive strains (Dequervain's, lateral epicondylitis, rotator cuff, CTS)
- 4. Hand fractures
- 5. Wrist fractures
- 6. Elbow fractures
- 7. Proximal humeral fractures

<u>Medications</u>: Be aware of their indications, as well as side effects and precautions in physiotherapy:

- 1. Coumadin, blood thinners, Neurontin, Lyrica
- 2. General contraindications for commonly used modalities (U.S., TENS, E-STIM, heat, ice)

## **Assessment/Treatment:**

- 1. Goniometry, U/E, hand, elbow, shoulder
- 2. Strength testing
- 3. Sensory testing
- 4. General principles of treatment for swelling, decrease ROM, decrease strength, pain.
