To prepare for your placement, please review the following:

Conditions/Topics:

- 1. Joint replacements (total shoulders, TKA, THA posterior vs. lateral approach)
- 2. Acetabular fractures (anterior vs posterior wall) and acetabular ORIF (anterior vs posterior approach)
- 3. High tibial osteotomies and knee ligamentous repairs
- 4. Sarcomas: Soft tissue, osteosarcomas
- 5. Intramedullary rodding vs ORIF
- 6. Discectomies vs Spinal fusions

<u>Medications</u>: Be aware of their indications, as well as side effects and precautions in physiotherapy:

- 1. Oxycontin vs. oxycodone
- 2. Morphine
- 3. Ativan
- 4. Lyrica
- 5. PCA and CPNB infusion pumps

Assessment/Treatment:

- 1. Goniometer principles
- 2. Manual Muscle Testing and grading
- 3. Dermatomes and myotome groups
- 4. ROM exercises for various joints
- 5. Strengthening exercises for various muscles and muscle groups
- 6. Gait patterns and the use of walking aids (i.e walker, crutches, cane) with various weight bearing status (WBAT, PWB. NWB)
- 7. How to teach going up and down stairs with walking aids
