Complete all tests before you see the doctor.

 Hormonal Blood Tests (FSH, LH, E2, Prolactin, TSH) You can do these tests on the same day of your baseline vaginal ultrasound appointment. No appointment necessary. Blood test for CMV (IgG &IgM), HIV, HepBAg, Hep B core Ab (IgG IgM), HepC, VDRL, rubella, CBC, blood type and RH factor and hemoglobin electrophoresis. No appointment necessary. (*see opening hours on page 2) Make sure you have a requisition (available from the nursing station). Fasting is not required for these tests.  Cervical culture for chlamydia and gonorrhoea On Day 1 of your cycle (regular flow bleeding), acall 514-843-1650 Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. to take an appointment. 	This test must be done when you are not menstruating.	MUHC Reproductive Centre 888 de Maisonneuve East, Suite 200

Step #2

Book an appointment with our psychologist. If you have a partner, he must be present at the appointment. If he cannot be present, then he must submit a letter stating his approval of the egg donation.

Step #3

Make an appointment with your doctor, for you and your donor egg recipient, to review your test results and sign the consent form. A medical order for egg donation will be added to your file. Complete and return the form for Egg Donor Details. Other tests such as genetic testing could be ordered by the doctor.

Step #4

Treatment calendar: A nurse will call your donor egg recipient to schedule an appointment to establish a treatment plan; you will need to be present at this appointment.
