



Tests (Mandatory)

Make sure both you and your partner have done the following blood tests in the past 12 months:

- Hepatitis B Antigen
- Hepatitis C
- HIV
- Hep B core Ab (IgG & IgM)
- VDRL



Consent (Mandatory)

Both you and your partner must read, complete and sign in the presence of a witness (e.g. friend or family member) the consent form titled: IVF/IVM Consent Form. The content of this form should have been discussed with your physician during your visit. If you have further questions regarding the form, please call: 514-843-1650 option 0 to request an appointment with your physician.



Orientation (Mandatory)

You are required to attend our orientation session on in vitro treatment procedures at the MUHC Reproductive Centre, located at 888, de Maisonneuve East, 2nd Floor. On the day of Orientation, follow the signs straight to the Primrose Amphitheatre.



Payment (Mandatory)

You are required to make the necessary payment **prior** to obtaining your treatment calendar. Please call 514-843-1650 to make an appointment to see the accountant on the day of your calendar appointment.



Attention!

All the above steps must be completed before a calendar can be issued. If any steps are missing, you will need to call to reschedule your calendar appointment to a later date when all missing steps have been completed.



Treatment Calendar

You must obtain a calendar appointment in order to start your treatment. On the day of your calendar appointment, be sure to bring:

- Hospital Cards and RAMQ if available
- Consents already completed and signed
