



CALL FOR CANDIDATES: ELECTION OF THE NEXT CAMILLE-LEFEBVRE PAVILLON RESIDENTS' COMMITTEE

WHAT IS THE RESIDENTS' COMMITTEE

The Mandate of the Residents' Committee (RC) of the Camille-Lefebvre Pavilion is to:

- Inform residents of their rights and obligations
- Promote the improvement of the quality of living conditions for residents;
- Evaluate the degree of satisfaction of the residents with the services obtained;
- Defend the collective rights and interests of the residents or, at the request of a resident, his or her rights and interests as a resident with the establishment or any competent authority.

COMMITTEE COMPOSITION

The RC of the Camille-Lefebvre Pavilion has a minimum of three (3) volunteer members, with the majority being residents. Other members may be family members, legal representatives or caregivers of residents.

- The majority of members are elected by and among the residents.
- The remaining members are also elected by the residents.
- Once the committee is formed, one member is designated to also serve on the MUHC Central Users' Committee.

CRITERIA TO STAND FOR ELECTION

The Candidate

- Must be a resident or a family member, legal representative or caregiver of a resident;
- Must not be an employee, supplier or service provider of the MUHC and/or of its research institute and/or one of its foundations;
- Must not be under curatorship;
- Must not have a criminal record;
- Must not have served on the MUHC Central User Committee in the last three years.

WHAT TO SUBMIT TO BE CONSIDERED AND BY WHAT DATE

The Candidate Form

- Anyone interested in serving on the committee must complete and email the **candidate form no later than Friday, March 10 at 12:00 p.m.** The election president will approve or reject the submissions based on the above criteria within a reasonable timeframe, approximately one week. **The e-mail address of the election president is: Me Mathilde Crépeau: mcrepeau@mbavocats.ca**

- Residents requiring technical support in submitting their candidate form are encouraged to request assistance from a family member or caregiver.
