

## Notice to area residents and businesses

Dear Madam or Sir,

On October 18, 2010, Groupe immobilier santé McGill (GISM) will begin installation of the foundation piles as it continues to excavate and put in place temporary excavation support walls (soldier pile walls, i.e. steel piles with timber lagging).

## Construction schedule

Work will be undertaken from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday <u>until November 2010 for the supporting walls</u>, and from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m., Monday to Saturday <u>until February 2011 for the piles</u>.

The excavation work will continue as planned by adhering to the current schedule of Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. until December 2010. The truck trips that are required to evacuate the day's excavated soil will take place from Monday to Saturday between 5 p.m. and 11 p.m.

## The foundations

Approximately 6,000 piles and some 18,500 m³ of concrete will be needed to build the foundations of the new Glen Campus of the McGill University Health Centre. These piles are necessary due to the soil characteristics to ensure a safe footing for the building. The foundation work will continue through the winter to be completed in August 2011.

Please be assured that we are sensitive to the inconveniences that a construction site of this size can cause, and that we will keep you informed of any changes that arise during the construction phase.
